Effect of food Food does not significantly affect absorption. Giving the dose within 30 minutes of food

or enteral nutrition may help with nausea.2

Warnings Hazard.¹ Do not crush the tablet.

Occupational exposure may be harmful. Do not crush or disperse the tablet if you are

pregnant. Contact a pharmacist or a medicines information service for advice.

Other May cause dry mouth.1

What to do for people with enteral feeding tubes

Do not crush or break the tablet.1

Hospital pharmacies can prepare a 5 mg/mL suspension in ORA-Blend that is suitable for nasogastric and gastrostomy tubes.2

Wear gloves when measuring and giving the dose. Contact with the skin causes irritation and a rash.2

Gently invert the bottle to re-suspend the contents. Do not shake.²
